2	Chateau Saint-Jeanne 2010	Corbieres 13.5% Super U Malansac	€4.15 Nowhere near number 1 in value.
3	Chateau Grand Moulin 2009 Jean-Noel Bousquet www.chateaugrandmoulin.com	Corbieres Boutenac 14.5% Intermache Redon	€10.95 Magnificent a supper wine.

4	Chateau Roquepine 2009 Gerard Bertrand	Coteaux du Languedoc La Clape 14% Super U Malansac	€7.89 You might get the Clape with this wine but not really worth its price.
5	Terrasses De Mayline 2012 Cave de Roquebrun	Saint Chinian 13% Super U Malansac	€4.11 Very average.
6	Chateau les Pins 2009	Cotes du Roussillon Villages 14.5% Cavavin, Redon	€10.50 A must for anyone from St Jacut Les Pins is this wine. Really well worth the money.
7	Les Sorcieres de Montmal 2011	Fitou 14% Cavavin, Redon	€7.70 At its price this was maybe the best wine tasted. Really good value.
8	Chateau Villerambert Julien	Minervois 14% Cavavin, Redon	€12.35 I wouldn't pay that much for this wine.
