1	Crement d'Alsace Arthur Metz Brut 2011	Super U Malansac 13% 6.49	As usual very good and well worth the price.
2	Edelzwicker Jean Geiler 2011	Leclerc Redon 12.5% €3.29	A little thin in flavour but what can be expected at €3.29
3	Riesling 2012 Medale d'Argent 2013	Intermache Redon 12.5% €4.10	A nice example of Riesling.

4	Muscat Albert Schoech 2012	Leclerc Redon 12.5% €4.90	Very nice.
5	Pinot Noir Rebmann 2012	Leclerc Redon 12.5% €4.76	Hmmm well this turned out to be red and chilled was not good. Next morning the dregs were just wonderful. Recommended.
6	Pinot Blanc Jean Geiler 2011 Reserve Particuliere	Leclerc Redon 13% €5.15	Super wine.
7	Gewurztraminer 2012	Intermache Redon 13% €5.75	Gewurtztraminer drinkers fall into two catagories. Like or Loathe. I like and for me this is a perfect wine for the Turkey at Christmas or Thanksgiving (American).
8	Gewurztraminer Heim Grand Cru Markruin 2012	Cavavin, Redon 13% €9.50	This one was even better.
9	Gewurztraminer Wolfberger 2012 Mundus Vini Deutschland 2012	Leclerc Redon 12.5% €19.20 50cl	A superb wine for a desert but at €28 a bottle (75cl) there are more reasonably priced wines. For those in the Loathing sector 7, 8 and 9 were just not nice. Try them and make your own decision.
