

## Wine Tasting No 54 19 March 2019 at 3 La Vacherie 56220 St Jacut Les Pins



1	Coteaux Bourguignons	Intermache Redon 12.0% €3.59	Julian thought this tasted like wine blended with water but the rest of us quite liked it and the price revealed that it is very good value for money.
2	Macon Blason de Bourgogne 2016	Intermache Redon 12.0% €4.90	Kate guessed nearest. Most of us found the wine had a rather sweet taste, not unpleasant but not really appealing.

3	Coteaux Bourgogne Maison Louis Girard 2016	Intermache Redon 12.5% €3.90	I think this was Kate's favourite of the night. No nose but a lovely flavour and good value.
4	Bourgogne Hautes-Cotes de Beaune 2017	Intermache Redon 12.0% €7.95	Just regarded as nice. Everyone underpriced this one.
5	Mercury Vin de Bourgogne 2017	Intermache Redon 12.5% €9.94	Chris liked it but most thought it was just ordinary and not worth the money.
6	Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2017	Intermache Redon 12.5% €7.20	A nice wine and good value for money. Worth buying at the price.
7	Beaune 1 <sup>st</sup> Cru Chateau de Meursault 2013	Intermache Redon 13.0% €31.95	No-one guessed the price of this one. All guesses were under and Glynn thought he would pay €1.99  This really was the best wine of the night and if you can afford 32 Euro for a bottle then why not.  A good nose and good on the palate.
8	Nuits Saint Georges 2013	Intermache Redon 13.0% €39.95	The price guesses went up quite a bit for this one but still everyone underpriced it. Everyone thought it was too much to pay but our connoisseur in Nuits Saint Georges thought it was great and the rest of us allowed him to finish the bottle.
