2	Macon Villages Barrier 2017	Shop Leclerc 12.5% €5.82	We thought this was a very nice wine super for a sunny day on the terrace. Good value for money.
3	Bourgogne Hautes Cotes de Nuit 2017	Shop Intermarche 12.5% €9.50	A nice wine but not as soft as no 2.
4	Macon Villages G L Fay 2017	Shop Intermarche 12.5% €5.98	Almost everyone preferred the Macon Villages No 2
5	Domaine des Mouchottes Bourgogne Aligote 2017	Shop Leclerc 12.5% €5.75	Not really a wine most of us would buy again.
6	Chablis Premier Cru Vaillons 2016	Shop Leclerc 12.5% €30.90	Most guessed this one around 10 Euro based on taste. Two tasters trying to be clever thought it was worth around 18 Euro but I think that was only because it is a Premier Cru ie the first pressing. The conclusion was that it was not even worth that. A great disappointment and certainly not good value for money.

7	Joseph Drouhin Pouilly-Vinzelles 2016	Shop Cavavin 13.0% €16.95	A really good wine. Mellow and good on the palate.
8	Pascal Enaud Pouilly-Fuisse 2017	Shop Cavavin 13.5% €17.95	Ah the poorly pussy. We got price guesses ranging from 30 Euro down to an insulting 2.99. A good wine but the Pouilly-Vinzelles was better.
