1	Vouvray Chateau Moncontour Demi-Sec	Super U Malansac 12.5% €6.15	For several who prefer Brut this Demi-Sec was not too sweet and much better with a slice of Judith's excellent cake.
2	Tourangelle Sauvignon Blanc 2018	Leclerc Redon 12.5% €4.80	A fresh and crisp white wine which everyone seemed to love. Very good value for money.
3	Domaine du Gaec Brangers Sauvignon Blanc Mentou Salon 2018	Leclerc Redon 13.5% €9.95	Some felt this was a little on the dry side but white wine lovers generally liked it but not the price compared with No 2

4	Le Fontenaux Saint Nicolas de Bourguer Bio Wine 2018	Lecerc Redon 13.0% €8.40	The first red of the night tasted a bit thin and everyone under-priced it.
5	Caves de la Tourangelle 2017 Gamay Noir	Leclerc Redon 12.5% €4.80	Another wine from the Caves de La Tourangelle and it was classed as very good and especially when the price was seen. Almost everyone overpriced it. At least on at double the price.
6	Bourgueil Les Hauts de Carroi 2018	Super U Malansac 13.0% €4.70	An excellent wine and very good value for money. Go quickly to Malansac as I'll be there this afternoon! 4.70 a bargain.
7	Chinon Le Bourg Bio Wine 2018	Super U Malansac 13.0% €12.50	Not many were anywhere near on the price of this. Not good value for money and probably priced on its name.
8	La Piffaudiere Malbec 2018	Cavavan Redon 12.5% €12.20	A very attractive label and an unusual Malbec. It went down well and several were very near the price.  However, there were wines of better value.
